Details

- Course examinations are scheduled to be written the last two days of each semester in class.
- All exams must be written at scheduled times (unless otherwise arranged)
- Weight of exams: 20% to 40% of total course grade.
- Information on Provincial Exams is located on the Ministry of Education website: <http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/exams/>
- Provincial Exams required for graduation are: English 10, Science 10, a Math 10, Social Studies 11 or First Nations 12, and English 12, English 12 First Peoples or Communications 12.
- Students should meet with a counsellor about the need to write Provincial Exams in other subject areas.
- The schedule for Provincial Exams is set by the Ministry of Education and are the only times during the year that these exams can be written. The exam schedule can be found in the Parent Handbook and Calendar & the Student Agenda
